1. Climate legislation and regulations should strive for an 80% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.
2. In mandated emissions limits we'd like to see that whatever the method of allocation, whether auction or not, the benefit goes to the public rather than industry.
3. We want provisions that consider the special situation of low-income citizens in anything that increases prices, whether energy costs or carbon penalties.
4. We want there to be funding to address the needs of those impacted by climate change locally and worldwide.
